

## CHPD March Activities


- Alarm Permits – See the city website to register alarms on line.








## Investigation Highlights

- **Shell Robbery** – Detectives were called out. A multi-agency search found no suspects. A Murray 7-11 was robbed 1 hour later by suspects with the same description. No further leads.
- **Fleeing** – A suspect vehicle fled from Officer Wyatt. 2 search warrants were later executed one on the car, one on the home of the suspects. Detectives found stolen checks, computers and narcotics. Charges are soon to be filed.
- **Attempted Strong Arm** – A 30 year old suspect attempted to take 2 vehicles from the drivers at Reams parking lot. One victim was a 68 year old female.
- **Elder Abuse** - Son took mother's narcotic prescriptions and defrauded her out of money. Still under investigation.
- **Sex Abuse** - 2 felony rape charges were filed on 2 juveniles. Excessive Alcohol involved. The parents of the girl thought she was at a sleep over party with girlfriends.
- **Embezzlement Charges filed on 09 case** involving a firm that once occupied the office across from the PD. Over \$600,000 was stolen by their accountant.








# Council District Breakdown


