4.1 <u>Public Works Report – Public Works Director, Matt Shipp.</u>

4.1.1 Public Works Director, Matt Shipp, presented the Public Works Report for the month of December 2017 and stated that seasonally, things have changed as snow plowing took over the top number this last month. There were three weather events where 119 tons of regular salt and 113 tons of the high-performance salt were utilized for the 5.5 inches of snow received. Standard Public works activities included keeping the roads dry. Mr. Shipp reported that they are in the process of completing crack sealing. The Fort Union Boulevard and La Cresta Project continues to move forward. The Fort Union Boulevard and Highland Drive Project was combined so they will not bid that out until the other is ready to go. He stated they have will their inaugural meeting with the committee to review the Pavement Management Study and set things in motion. The summer projects were to include 2700 East and the Fort Union Boulevard Resurfacing Project.
