## RESOLUTION NO. 2015-59

### A RESOLUTION RATIFYING A DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER CONCERNING THE QUAIL HOLLOW FIRE

**WHEREAS**, the city of Cottonwood Heights (the “City”) suffered damages to approximately 30 acres of property at the area west of Wasatch Blvd. and 9100 South, directly south of the Metropolitan Water of Salt Lake and Sandy facility, as a result of fire which occurred on September 1, 2015, beginning at approximately 10:00 a.m., which was caused by an underground electrical transformer which exploded nearby; and

**WHEREAS**, the magnitude of the incident and the associated response and recovery costs exceed the resources available to the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City’s city council (the “Council”) met in regular session on 8 September 2015 to consider, among other things, ratifying a “Disaster Declaration–Quail Hollow Fire” (the “Declaration”) issued effective 1 September 2015 by the City’s Manager and Mayor by authority of the Utah Code and Constitution, including, without limitation, UTAH CODE ANN. Title 53, Chapter 2a, Part 2, Disaster Response and Recovery Act; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council has reviewed the form of the Declaration, a photocopy of which is annexed hereto; and

**WHEREAS**, after careful consideration, the Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of City’s residents to ratify the Declaration as proposed;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the city council of the city of Cottonwood Heights that the attached Declaration is hereby ratified and approved.

This Resolution, assigned no. 2015-59, shall take effect immediately upon passage.

## DISASTER DECLARATION--QUAIL HOLLOW FIRE

Title 53, Chapter 2a, Part 2, Disaster Response and Recovery Act, that the Mayor and the Manager of Cottonwood Heights hereby declare a local disaster and emergency to exist for a period of 30 days from the date of this resolution, unless renewed or extended;
