

Wasatch Blvd Trail Phase III

Project Schedule

Construction: October – November 2011

Overview

Salt Lake County and the Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) are installing bicycle lanes along Wasatch Boulevard from 8350 South to the 6200 South Park and Ride lot, a popular bicycling corridor.

The purpose of this project is to improve mobility and safety along the corridor by providing a separate bike lane for bicyclists and connectivity to the Big Cottonwood Trail. Elements of the project include marked bicycle lanes on both sides of the roadway, directional arrow and bike symbol pavement markings and signage.

Construction begins Monday, October 17th near 8350 South and work will move northbound along Wasatch Blvd. Impacts during construction will be minimal during peak hour traffic with intermittent one lane closures during off-peak hours. Cyclists may experience some daily/hourly interruptions to the existing bike lanes.
